You can give this report to whoever you want, I don't care, just don't edit anything :)

I did a little test in November 2007 with YouTube and 2 MaxBounty ringtone offers.

Basically what I did was:

1. Download the Britney Spears music video "Gimme More" (I love that song...just kidding).
2. Edit it and put my domain that redirects to my ringtone affiliate URL at the beginning and end with something like "Get This Ringtone Free! <ENTER> FreeRingtonesYay.com"
3. Re-upload it on one of my accounts. Make the title "Britney Spears – Gimme More (Awesome Vid!)"
4. Make the description "http://FreeRingtonesYay.com <ENTER> Get This Ringtone Free!"
5. That's it.

After that I only looked at the video a few times, but when searched for it came

up #3 for "Britney Spears Gimme More" on YouTube.

I started to earn a little bit of money with the MaxBounty "PlayPhone Ringtones" offer and then I got an email from my affiliate manager telling me that I'm not allowed to use the word "FREE" when promoting this offer, and to use the "Jamster Hot Tones" offer instead.

I switched the offer and actually got quite a bit higher Earnings Per Click so it worked out better anyway.

On November 19, 2007 I got an email from YouTube telling me that they were taking my video down due to a copyright claim by some company that represents Britney Spears.

So, the money is there. I'd recommend using a non-copyrighted video and a free offer vs. something that someone has to buy.

Another thing to note is that non-US traffic through MaxBounty is usually redirected to paid surveys offers, as you can see above next to SurveyScout. It doesn't convert very well.
